At a Glance

POSITION OF HEAD COACH

- Season: Will run intertwined with minor box season until the end of July.
- Expectations: HC will need to attend all evaluations, camps, practices, ex games, and competition.
- Collaboration: HC will be expected to collaborate with local clubs to plan schedule. HC will need to assist in the hiring of assistant coaches and manager.

Position Profile

HEAD COACH

The Alberta Lacrosse Association (ALA) is currently on a province wide search for Head Coaches for the 2023 Alberta Summer Games.

There are eight (8) zones across the province, and coaches should apply for the positions in their own zone. The zones are: Sunny South, Big Country, Calgary, Parkland, Black Gold/Yellowhead, Edmonton, North Eastern Alberta, Peace Country.

POSITION OUTLINE

Commitment

HC will be expected to lead their team from date of hire, through competition. This includes but is not limited to evaluations, camps, practices, exhibition games, meetings, team building, and other tasks as required.

Travel

Coaches will be required to travel within their teams' zone for evaluations, camps, practices, and any other team events, and for the competition. Travel, accommodation, and food will be covered as required.

Schedule

Schedule to be determined upon finalization of coaching staffs. Schedules will be made in collaboration with local clubs within zone and the ALA.

KEYS TO SUCCESS

- 01 Program development. Team systems and expectations. Team culture and team building.
- 02 Athlete development. Develop players through camps, practices, exhibition events, and competition.
- 03 Coach development. Develop relationships and foster growth for assistant coaches through mentorship, roles, responsibilities.
- 04 Ability to collaborate. Need to be able to work with your teams, coaches, manager, zone, LGB, and ALA.

QUALIFICATIONS

- 01 Head Coach must be Competition Introduction Certified or have the ability to become certified prior to competition.
- 02 Lacrosse coaching background, proven knowledge of the game.
